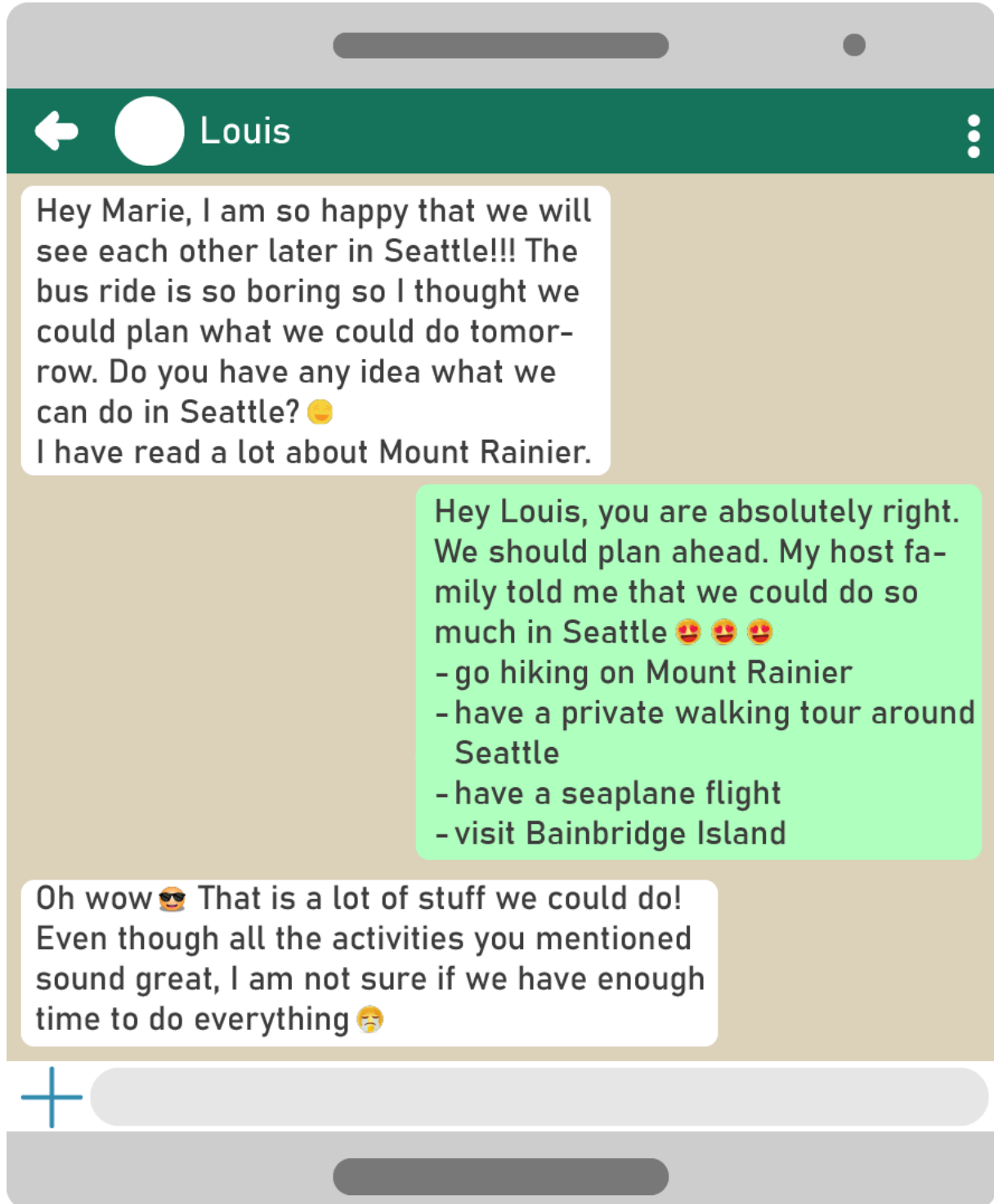


## Jigsaw puzzle: A day in Seattle

## Group 1: Mount Rainier Day Tour from Seattle

**Duration:** 10 hours

**Price:** \$128

**How to get there:** by bus

**Weather:** more fun if sunny

### Overview

While in the State of Washington, take a day tour of Mt. Rainier National Park with a hotel pickup from downtown Seattle. Watch a presentation about the park at the visitor center, and enjoy a journey into the natural region to see Christine Falls, Narada Falls, and Mt. Rainier. Experience the beauty of this nationally preserved outdoor area with help from a guide who knows the best ways around the park.

Make your way inside the park, and admire its beauty as you first walk to Christine Falls and then further down the Nisqually River to the 188-foot-high (57-meter-high) Narada Falls. Lastly, stop at Paradise, and catch sight of its stunning meadows (Wiesen). Look up to see one of the Cascade Range's and Washington's tallest mountains, Mt. Rainier.

### Overview

Fly from Seattle to Friday Harbor on a 6-passenger seaplane, and enjoy spectacular views of the San Juan Islands. Flying over the San Jan Islands is a great way to take in the scale of the hundreds of islands, and remote (abgelegen) beaches that line the Washington coast, and you'll touch down in the charming island town of Friday Harbor, which is linked to the main-land by ferry. Flying to San Juan Island means more time for exploring along the Seattle sky-line and see Bill Gates' estate, (Anwesen) Spot whales, eagles, and other wildlife from the air and Land at San Juan Island's and Friday Harbor.
