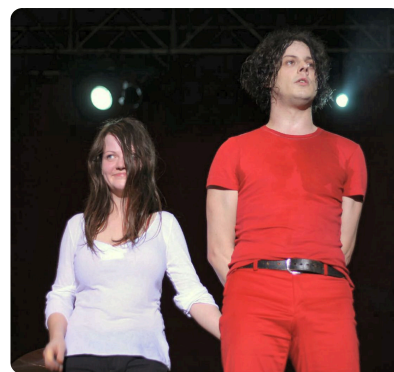




We're Going to Be Friends
