

# adverbs and adjectives



## ADVERBS

**Adverbs** are used to **describe verbs, adjectives** or other **adverbs**.

Adverbs answer: *how, when, where, why, how often or how much.*

For example: *That puppy runs **slowly**.*



## ADJECTIVES

**Adjectives** are used to **describe a noun or pronoun**.

Adjectives often come before the word they describe.

For example: *That is a **cute** puppy.*



## More examples:

1. Sarah thinks **quickly**. (Adv.)
2. We performed **badly**. (Adv.)



## More examples:

1. Sarah is a **quick** thinker. (Adj.)
2. Our performance was **bad**. (Adj.)
