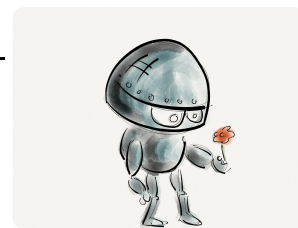

am/is/are + going to + infinitive

We use it to talk about ...

fixed plans or intentions for the future.

Example(s): I'm going to work when I'm

something that will very probably happen because you can already see signs for it.

infinitive, but we add an „-s“ for the 3rd person

We use it to talk about ...

1.1 present progressive with future meaning

am/is/are + -ing-form + phrase about future time (like „on Saturday“)

We use it to talk about ...

something that is definitely planned or

Example(s):

We are having a barbecue on Saturday.
