 - Sir Toby: Has he got a pet?
- Miss Molly: Have you got a pet, Mr Jones?
 - Jones: A pet? Yes, I have. I've got a black cat. It's called Hotter. Parry Hotter.
- Miss Molly: He has got a black cat, grandpa. He calls it Parry Hotter.
- Sir Toby: Harry Potter? I don't like Harry Potter.
- Miss Molly: Be quiet, grandpa.

Jones: Perhaps your cat is in the woods, Miss Molly. I'll go to the woods and look for your cat.

Miss Molly: If you look for a cat you will never find my parrot! Please, find Polly!

Jones: Ah, you're missing a parrot, I forgot. I must go now, Miss Molly. I'll call you later.

- Miss Molly: It's Mr Jones, the detective.
- Lady Jane: Where is he?
- Miss Molly: He is in the woods.
- Lady Jane: Why is he in the woods?
- Miss Molly: He is looking for Polly, I told you.
- Lady Jane: He is licking a lolly? In the woods?
- Miss Molly: He isn't licking a lolly, he's looking for Polly, my parrot.
- Sir Toby: Dolly? Who's Dolly?
- Miss Molly: Be quiet, grandpa.
- Lady Jane: When will he be back?
- Miss Molly: When will you be back, Mr Jones?
- Jones: I don't know. First I have to find Polly.
- Miss Molly: He has to find Polly first. Then he will come back.
- Sir Toby: I don't like black, I love pink!
- Miss Molly: Shut up, grandpa!
