What are **Conjunctions**?



...are words that link other words, phrases and sentences together.

You can distinguish between three different types of conjunctions and each conjunction has different linking words:

Coordinating Conjunctions...

...connect two words or groups of words with the same grammatical structure.

Example:

Marc <u>and</u> Andrew cooked dinner together.

Subcoordinating Conjunctions...

...connect dependent clauses with independent clauses.

Example:

I will help you <u>whenever</u> you need me.

Correlative Conjunctions...

...connect words, phrases and sentences with complementary relationships. They are always used in pairs.

Example:

<u>Neither</u> he <u>nor</u> she enjoys math.


