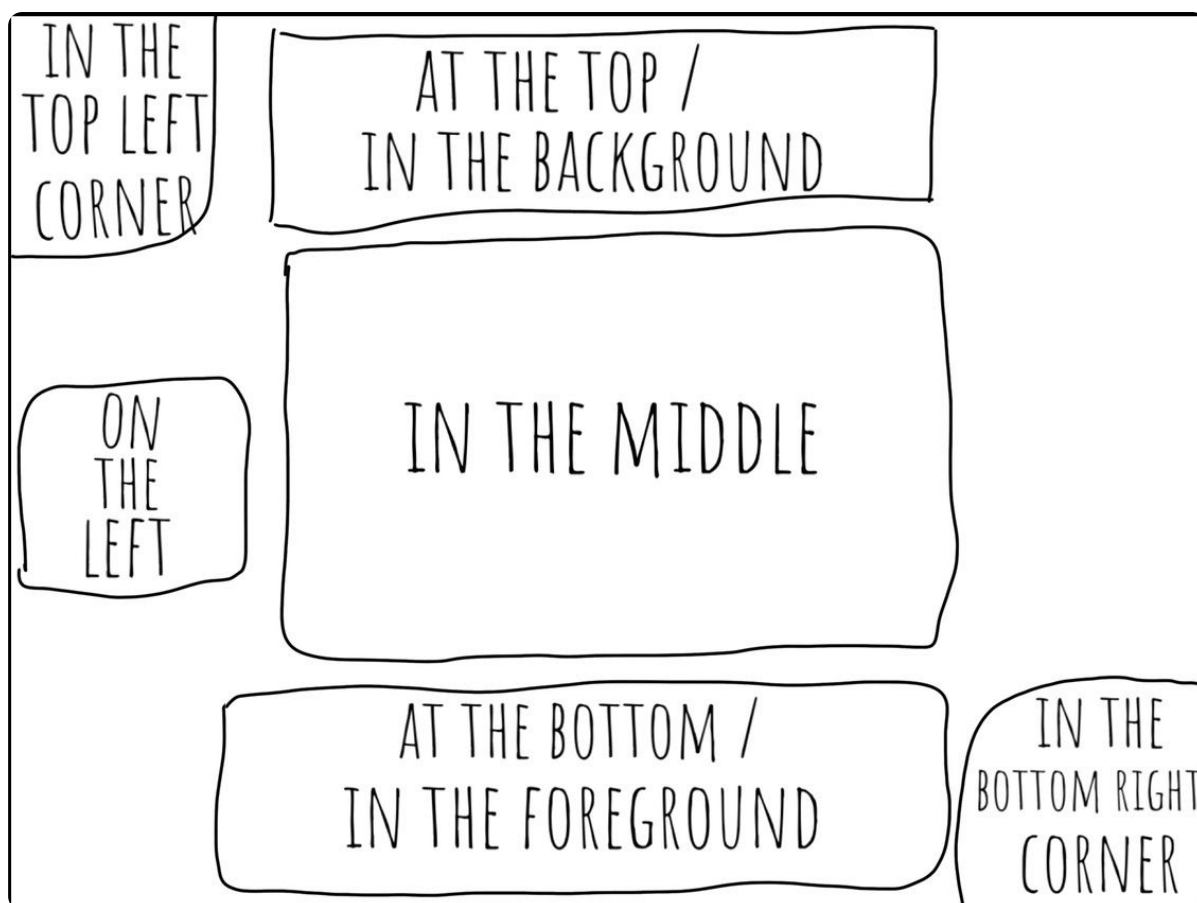




Step 1 - Introduction

What: can you see / kind of picture is it?
 Where: was the picture taken?
 Who: is on the picture?
 When: was the picture taken/published?
 (A general description, keep it **short**)

The picture shows... / On the picture is|are...
 The picture was taken in...
 There is/are... on the picture
 The picture was taken in.../published on...

Step 2 - A detailed Description

- Start in the middle
- choose your path (top to bottom/ bottom to top/left to right)
- Who is doing what/What is happening?
remember: use the present progressive (is/am/are and verb+ing)

In the center/middle I can see/there is
 On the bottom a ... is shown/pictured.
 In the top right corner the picture shows ...
 The man/woman is... / The people are...
 The car/helicopter is...

Step 3 - Interpretation and your opinion

I think... / In my opinion the picture shows ... / Maybe the picture shows ... / It could be that...
 I like/don't like the picture because... / What I really love/hate about the picture is ...
 The picture makes me think of... / When I look at this picture ... comes to my mind.
