And what about museums? I want to see the Nefertiti!	If you (go to) <i>Neue Museum</i> at <i>Museumsinsel</i> , you (be able to) see <i>Nefertiti</i> . There are many different museums like <i>Pergamonmuseum</i> and <i>Alte Nationalgalerie</i> .
