3. BTS is a famous K-Pop group with a fan group called "ARMY." They got a #1 hit in America called **Dynamite**. The **Dynamite** video broke YouTube's record with 101 million views in 24 hours.
4. K-Pop is influenced by Korean culture, like clothes and beauty trends.
5. K-Pop groups can have many members, sometimes up to 23.
6. Many K-Pop groups have their own personalized light sticks for fans.
