What is it?

A story cube has six sides, just like any normal cube. But instead of a number on each side, the sides show one important scene, figure or object from the book you're reading.

What do I need?

- cube template
- (colored) pencils

Example:

Step by step

1. Choose six key scenes, figures or objects
 - a) think about moments that are important
 - b) think about important figures
 - c) think about certain objects that are important to the plot
2. Design your cube
 - a) use the template, fold and glue it
 - b) draw one scene, figure or object per side
3. Prepare your presentation
 - a) when you're showcasing your story cube later on you should be able to explain the scenes, figures and objects
 - b) think about how you can explain those sides of your cube
