May 4: Victoria

Hey there everybody! Thanks for stopping by my travel blog. My name is Josephine Roy and I want to ride my bike across Canada. Six years ago I was sick with cancer. While this was a horrible experience, it made me change my life. I used to think I would do things later, but now I know I should follow my dreams now. That's why I took a break from my job as an engineer to start my ride across Canada.

I plan to ride between 60 and 90 kilometers a day, but not on Sundays. In total, more than 6,000 kilometers lie in front of me and I'll give myself four months. I don't have much money, so I'll sleep in my tent or stay with people who offer me a place. You can also buy me a cup of coffee online – I'll post a picture when I drink it.

Day 1, May 19: Victoria to Vancouver

After two years of planning, the day finally came! I took the ferry to Vancouver and then biked to my sister's house. There I enjoyed a last large meal and filled my backpack with food.

Day 2, May 20: Vancouver to Cultus Lake

I took the Skytrain to King George station and started biking. The highway was too busy because of the long weekend, so I switched to smaller roads. I had no problems with my legs and just enjoyed the ride. At Cultus Lake I put up my tent, cooked kidney bean soup, and went to bed early because of the cold.

Day 3, May 21: Cultus Lake to Othello

I woke up with birds singing and rode towards Othello. Soon I was on the Trans Canada Trail. My fears about problems, bears or loneliness disappeared and I enjoyed nature. The Othello tunnels were amazing – you can ride your bike right through them. In the evening I found a good place for my tent and fell asleep.

September 4: Halifax

It's September now and I made it! I'm in Halifax, Nova Scotia. I rode 6,257 kilometers, had three flat tires and one broken bike chain. I didn't meet a bear close up and I still like myself. I met many amazing people and I'm thankful for this trip. I've never felt so alive as during the last 108 days.
