1 Rules and Application



[Past Progressive

A verb tense used to describe ongoing or continuous actions that were happening in the past



「「Rule

It is formed by combining the past tense of the verb "to be" (was/were) with the present participle of the main verb (the verb ending in -ing).



i Breakdown of how to form the Past Progressive

- 1. **Subject (noun or pronoun):** This is the person or thing performing the action.
- 2. Past tense of "to be" (was/were): Use "was" with singular subjects (I, he, she, it) and "were" with plural subjects (you, we, they).
- 3. **Present participle of the main verb (verb + -ing):** Add -ing to the base form of the main verb.

Subject+Past tense of "to be"+Present participle of the main verb



Examples

I was playing video games when the phone rang.

In this sentence, "I" is the subject, "was" is the past tense of "to be," and "playing" is the present participle of the main verb "play." Together, they form the past progressive tense.

They were studying for their exams all night.

• In this case, "They" is the subject, "were" is the past tense of "to be," and "studying" is the present participle of the main verb "study."
