Tip: Remember to write about typical Australian things, like the Great Barrier Reef, Sydney, kangaroos, the outback, or the weather.

A postcard has the following parts:

1. Greeting: How do you start? (e.g., „Dear Mom and Dad,“ or „Hello from Australia!“)
2. Main part: Describe what you are doing in Australia (e.g., sightseeing, the weather, what you enjoy the most).
3. Closing: End your postcard with a nice closing sentence (e.g., „I miss you all“ or „See you soon!“)
4. Farewell: A friendly goodbye (e.g., „Lots of love,“ „Best wishes,“)
