I always **go** to school at half past seven.

In diesem Satz steht das Verb im simple present. Es ist unregelmäßig (*go - went - gone*).



Simple present

Das simple present verwenden wir bei Handlungen in der Gegenwart (Präsens). Schaue dir das Verb an.

- ② Schaue nun nach SIGNAL WORDS im Satz:

I **always** go to school at half past seven.



Signal words : simple present

always: immer
sometimes: manchmal
usually: gewöhnlich/ normalerweise
never: nie
every day/ week: jeden Tag/ jede Woche
seldom: selten
often: oft

- ① Schaue dir wieder als erstes das Verb im Satz an. In welcher Zeitform steht das Verb?

I **went** to school at 8 o'clock yesterday.

In diesem Satz steht das Verb im simple past. Es ist unregelmäßig (*go - went - gone*).



Simple past

Das simple past verwenden wir bei abgeschlossenen Handlungen in der Vergangenheit.

- ② Schaue nun nach SIGNAL WORDS im Satz:

I went to school at 8 o'clock **yesterday**.



Signal words : simple past

yesterday: gestern
last week: letzte Woche
last month: letzten Monat
in 2015: 2015
five days ago: vor fünf Tagen

? Do oder does?

Bei den Personalpronomen *I, you, we* und *they* verwendest du immer **do**.

"Do you play football every week?"

+ Yes, I do.

- No, I don't.

Bei *he, she it* verwendest du immer **does**.

"Does he play football every week?"

+ Yes. he does.

- No, he doesn't.

Dad: We go to the supermarket. Sarah, do you sometimes eat vegetables?

Sandra: Yes, I do.

Sandra: Mom, you go to the supermarket every week?

Mom: No, he .

They - usually - (to) come - to parties ?

last Monday	
last month	
five days ago	

② Setze **did** und **didn't** in die Lücken ein. Unterstreiche die *signal words*.

Ali: Mom, did you buy me the T-shirt yesterday?

Mom: No, I didn't. There was too much work to do.

Ali: Oh, okay. you visit aunt Sabbah last week?

Mom: Yes, I . She is feeling better now.

Ali: That's good to hear. she have the operation last Sunday?

Mom: No, she . Her leg was too swollen (*geschwollen*).

You - (to) go - to school - last weekend ?	Did you go to school last weekend?
Chris - sometimes - (to) play - with toys ?	
You - (to) speak - English - every day?	
Your mom - often - (to) go - shopping ?	
We - never - (to) cook - nice food ?	
They - usually - (to) come - to parties ?
