Present simple	Present continuous
Fimetabled events, e.g. TV programme or train de- parture (timetabled future)	Personal arrangements (diary future)
"The hair salon opens at 8 o'clock."	"I am getting my hair cut next week."
Going to + infinitive	Will + infinitive
Predictions (when you can see the evidence) "Look at the clouds. It's going to rain."	Predictions (based on no evidence) "I think it will rain in a few days."
Decisions already made "I'm going to get my hair cut."	Decisions made at the time of speaking (sponta neous) <i>"I will get my hair cut."</i>

- 3) Your predictions for the planet for 2050.

Predictions
 Predictions can be based on evidence or no evidence.
 When talking about your predictions for the planet for 2050, you can use both will-future or going-to future, depending on whether there is evidence or not.
 E.g.:

 I think there will be flying cars in 2050.
 Scientists say that Venice is going to be flooded by 2050. (Wissenschaftler haben Beweise dafür.)
