

Time-Turners and how to use them responsibly.

What is a Time-Turner?



A Time-Turner is a magical device used for time travel. It allows the user to go back in time for up to five hours. Going forwards in time (into the future) is not possible. Students of Hogwarts may apply for a Time-Turner in order to attend more classes during a school year. It is required of the students to follow a strict set of rules, or they lose access to the device. They most commonly look like an hourglass on a necklace.
