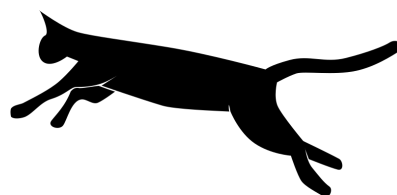


- ① Read the text and underline all the verbs of perception that you can find! Also, underline the participles and infinitives that follow. Use different colours for the different forms!



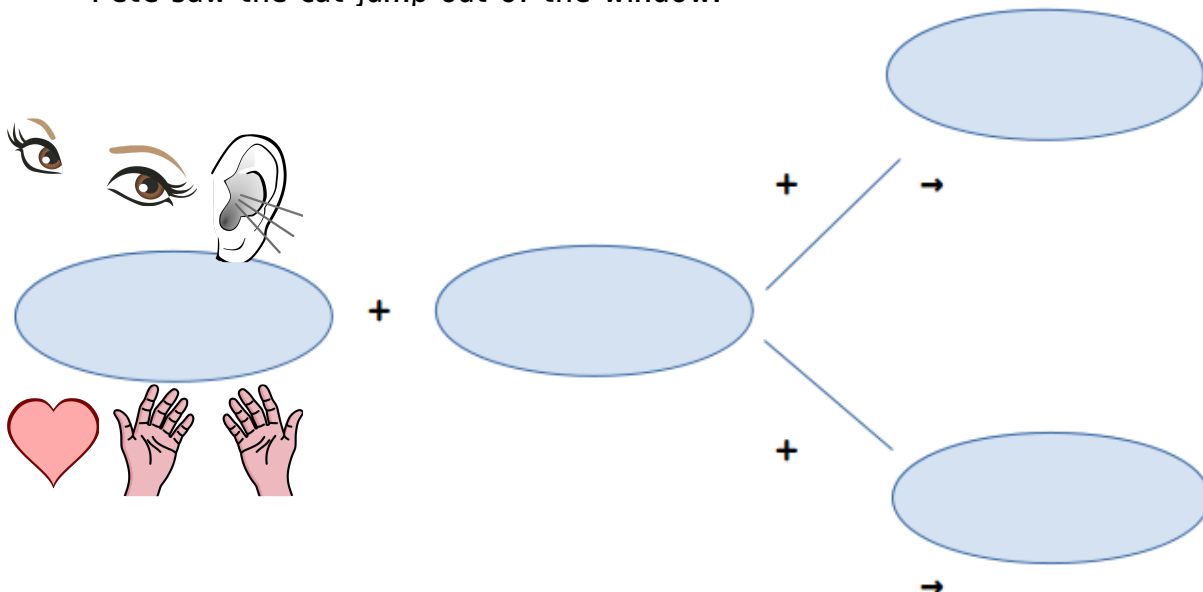
Pete sometimes helps the vet he met during his work experience. The vet wants to know why a woman with a cat left before her appointment...
