(1) Write a review on the movie "Sister Act". Your review should be structured with a title, an introduction, a body (main part) and a conclusion. The following information is there to help you:

<u>Title</u>: Your title should **include the name of the movie** and be interesting, if possible. However, don't stress too much about it.

**Introduction**: The purpose of the introduction is to **inform the reader about what is** being reviewed and engage the reader to make them interested and continue reading.

- **Engaging the reader**: Try to engage the reader from the beginning, by asking rhetorical questions, making interesting statements or highlighting a unique aspect of the movie.
- **General information**: Mention the movie's name, year of release, the genre, the director, and the main character, as well as the actor that played it. Also include a short summary what the movie is about, without giving away too much (avoid spoilers!)

**Body**: In the body, you should **give more details** and **explain your personal opinion** on the movie.

- more details: Provide the reader with more relevant details, about the overall tone of the movie, as well as sound design, visuals, and acting.
- personal opinion: Give your opinion on the aspects you liked or disliked. If possible, provide reasons, evidence or examples.

**Conclusion**: The purpose of the conclusion is to give your overall opinion and recommendation.

- overall opinion: Give your overall opinion on the movie, including a rating (up to five stars or a score out of 10).
- recommendation: To what group of people would you recommend this movie (e.g. families, children, nobody, everyone, people interested in history, ...)
