Simple Past

2. regular forms

To build the simple past you take the verb and add "-ed" at the end.

wash → washed ed → [d]

talk → talked

open → opened

play → played

start → started d/t → [ɪd] !

Be careful !

2a)

close → closed

The silent "e" (= das stumme „e“) at the end of the verb has to leave. Never use "ee" !
(hope → hoped , love → loved)

2b)

stop → stopped

The consonant (Mitlaut) at the end is doubled if the vowel (Selbstlaut) before is stressed (betont)

step → stepped (treten, schreiten)

plan → planned (planen)

swap → swapped (tauschen)

travel → travelled (reisen)

2c)

carry → carried

A "y" after consonants at the end of the verb is replaced (wird ersetzt) by "i".

tidy → tidid

hurry → hurriid
