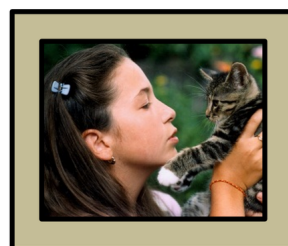

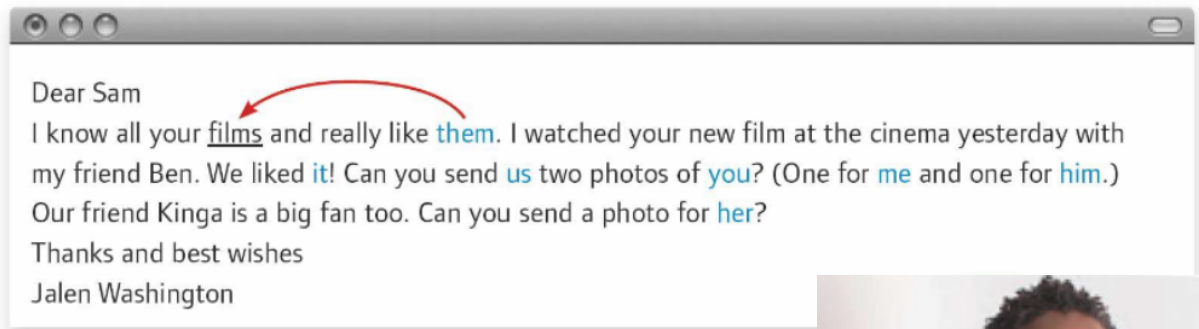

1. Subject Pronouns

I can see.	ich
You can see.	du
He/She/It can see.	er/sie/es
We can see.	wir
They can see.	sie (Plural)
You can see.	ihr

⇒ They replace a noun (Nomen) that does the action.

2. Object Pronouns

Tim can see	me.	→ mich
Tim can help	me.	→ mir
Tim can see	you.	→ dich
Tim can help	you.	→ dir
Tim can see	him.	→ ihn
Tim can help	him.	→ ihm
Tim can see	her.	→ sie
Tim can help	her.	→ ihr
Tim can see	it.	→ es
Tim can help	it.	→ ihm

Tim can see	us.	→ uns
Tim can help	us.	→ uns
Tim can see	you.	→ euch
Tim can help	you.	→ euch
Tim can see	them.	→ sie
Tim can help	them.	→ ihnen

They replace (ersetzen) a noun that takes the action. They are placed (werden platziert) after the verb.
